Subject: Demand for a Finding for Recovery for \$3,432.00, against  
Nicole Fontaine, Mayor Gary Norton, Jr., and Finance Director Irene Crowell, in  
the matter of Resolution 99-12.

Police Chief Spotts' hiring, and Mayor Gary Norton's approval of Nicole Fontaine as an employee within the Police Department is in violation of Resolution 99-12. Resolution 99-12 passed on September 18, 2012 and became effective on September 25, 2012, ordered a hiring freeze in the departments of Police, Fire, Finance, Parks and Recreation, Community Development, Housing, Helen S. Brown, and Human Resources.

At no time prior to the hiring of Nicole Fontaine did either Mayor Norton or Police Chief Spotts come before Council to request relief from Resolution 99-12 in the hiring of Nicole Fontaine, which is believed to have taken place sometime during the month of June 2013.

Council passed Resolution 109-11 on January 17, 2012, requiring the Mayor to provide to Council, on a quarterly basis, a schedule of essential personnel per department. To-date, Mayor Norton has not complied with this law. In addition, Council passed Ordinance 65-12 on July 17, 2012, requiring the Finance Director to provide Council with a bi-weekly report of each month that identifies the wages paid to each employee by name and job title of the municipal corporation. To-date, the Finance Director has been partially compliant with this law.

Based upon the limited number of bi-weekly reports provided to Council, the Audit Committee has noted the following payments to Nicole Fontaine. Ms. Fontaine was not listed in any payroll report prior to July 19, 2013.

The Audit Committee estimates that Nicole Fontaine's cash payments amounted to approximately \$3,443.00 in FY2013 to-date (Since we do not have an official start date we can only estimate payout), these estimates do not include Payroll Costs, or any accrued vacation time that may have been cashed out. **This represents, at minimum, approximately \$3,432.00 in illegal appropriations that must be returned to the General Fund of the City of East Cleveland**

### **STRICT LIABILITY**

In the Auditor of State's Bulletin 2008-006 on the subject of Strict Liability, it states: "Under Ohio law, any public official who either authorizes an illegal expenditure of public funds or supervises the accounts of a public office from which such illegal expenditure is made is strictly liable for the amount of the expenditure. *Seward v. National Surety Corp.*, 120 Ohio St. 47 (1929); 1980 Op. Att'y Gen. No. 80-074; Ohio Rev. Code Section 9.39; *State, ex. Rel. Village of Linndale v. Masten*, 18 Ohio St. 3d 228 (1985). Public officials controlling public funds or property are secondarily liable for the loss incurred should such funds or property be fraudulently obtained by another, converted, misappropriated, lost or stolen. Public officials will be liable if and to the extent that recovery or restitution is not obtained from the persons who unlawfully obtained such funds or property. 1980 Op. Att'y Gen. No. 80-074. "

### **THE CHARTER**

Section 113 of the East Cleveland Charter, states the general powers and duties of the mayor are *"The Mayor shall be the chief executive officer of the City, responsible for carrying out and fulfilling the intent and purpose of any and all legislation duly passed by the Council. The Mayor shall supervise the administration of all the affairs of the City and the conduct and administration of all departments and divisions thereof, except the Council and as otherwise provided by this Charter, and the Mayor shall have all such powers as are conferred upon Mayors by the laws of the State of Ohio. The Mayor shall be the chief conservator of the peace within the City and shall see that all laws, resolutions, and ordinances are enforced therein."*

### **LAW DIRECTOR'S OPINION**

Law Director Riley in an Opinion dated February 22, 2013, that covered several topics, stated: *"Time and again the question has been posed as to whether resolutions and ordinances are enforceable if the book titled "Codified Ordinances of the City of East Cleveland Ohio" has not been "officially" approved by Council by resolution. It should be patently clear to all observers that once an ordinance or resolution has been properly voted on and passed by Council and approved by the Mayor, that that enactment becomes the official local law regarding that specific matter. Additionally, it becomes effective and enforceable within the time frame stated in the body of the enactment irrespective of whether it has been included in the previously referenced book of Codified Ordinances. Were this not the case, none of the ordinances and resolutions enacted post Council approval would ever become enforceable. We all know that to be a non-sequitur. The sole purpose of Council's approval of the bound book of ordinances and resolutions is to provide the public with a convenient and accessible copy of the local laws and to give a basis for payment of the Walter H. Drane Co. for its service."*

*In summary, a single, unbound piece of legislation by Council is effective law once it has been properly enacted and approved and is effective and enforceable pursuant to the date stated therein."*

**AUDIT COMMITTEE JUDGMENT**

It is the unanimous judgment of the Audit Committee that Resolution 99-12 is law, as evidenced by the 2012 Council Legislative Docket, which Mayor Norton is duty-bound by the Charter to enforce. That Mayor Norton knowingly violated The Charter and Codified Ordinance 525.12(d)(e) when he illegally authorized the hiring of Nicole Fontaine as an employee within the Police Department and directed Finance Director Irene Crowell to pay Nicole Fontaine's salary.

Upon motion carried, the Audit Committee demands Ciuni & Panichi conduct a complete audit of all payments made to Nicole Fontaine, and immediately submit all documentation to the Auditor of State's Legal Office for a legal determination to confirm a Finding for Recovery against Nicole Fontaine, Mayor Gary Norton, and Finance Director Irene Crowell.

The Audit Committee further demands that all appropriate legal actions are taken to compel repayment at the earliest possible time, and that any other appropriate legal sanctions for violations of local or state laws will be pursued.


